

unAwards – Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
<p>Why are you only making awards to the unLab strand this Round when you previously had unLock and Starting Out strands?</p>	<p>This final round will focus on where we have observed the greatest demand for funds which has consistently been the unLab strand.</p>
<p>What do we mean by early or mid-career artists?</p>	<p>We have no hard and fast definition for these, but early-career might include artists within five years of practice, between one and three projects developed, and still establishing a clear creative voice. Mid-career might be artists with four or more projects developed and produced, a good understanding of their creative imperative, and perhaps have worked with other partners or in partnership with non-arts sector practitioners.</p>
<p>Do you have a template budget you would like applicants to use?</p>	<p>No, we're happy for you to submit the budget in your own template. If you're looking for a template (and other useful documents!), check out our Resources webpage here: https://unlimited.earth/resources/</p>
<p>With a priority for companies based in the North of England, would we</p>	<p>Yes. We have a number of priorities that we will consider as part of our decision-making and no single priority will be the sole reason for</p>

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fund a company outside of the North of England?	offering an award or rejecting an application. We will look at a balance between the application on its own merits, our priorities, and the range of applications submitted.
What is the difference between our eligibility criteria and our priorities?	Eligibility criteria are required to be met in full. Priorities are one of a number of considerations in the decision-making process.
Can we fund individual artists?	No. The awards are specifically for artists working together within an organisation.
Can we fund an unincorporated group through another third-party charitable organisation?	No. We will only offer awards directly to the arts or cultural organisation delivering the project and our funding agreement will be with the same organisation.
Can I apply to unAwards if I made an application in a previous round?	<p>Yes. Applications from previous recipients of grants or from previously unsuccessful applicants can apply again for unAwards. Applications will be considered on their own merits. Although the Panel & Trustees will have regard to the outcome of the previous grant, any new application will in no way receive preferential or adverse consideration.</p> <p>If you wish to resubmit the same proposal as before then we highly</p>

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	recommend that you consider how the context in which you are working has moved on and adapt your proposal accordingly.
